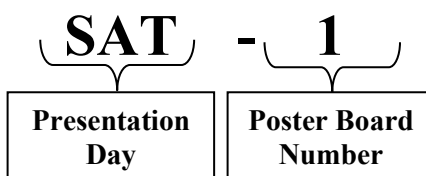


Information for ASBMR 2026 Annual Meeting Poster Presentations

Poster Instructions

- **Plenary Posters**
 - **Set up** - Friday, October 9 from 8:00 am – 12:00 pm.
 - **Poster presentations** - Friday, October 9 from 5:30 pm – 7:00 pm AND either Saturday, October 10 from 2:00 pm – 3:30 pm **OR** Sunday, October 11 from 2:00 pm – 3:30 pm, based on your assigned session. Please refer to your notification email for your assignment. The poster will remain on the board throughout the entire meeting and
 - **Take Down** - Sunday, October 11 by 4:30 pm. You are not required to present your poster on all days.
- All other posters are to be displayed only during your assigned poster session and removed after that session by 4:30 pm.
 - **All Poster Session I posters will be set up on Saturday, October 10 from 7:30 am – 9:30 am and will be presented on Saturday, October 10 from 2:00 pm-3:30 pm. These posters must be dismantled on Saturday, October 10 by 4:30 pm.**
 - **All Poster Session II posters will be set up on Sunday, October 11 from 7:30 am – 9:30 am and will be presented on Sunday, October 11 from 2:00 pm-3:30 pm. These posters must be dismantled on Sunday, October 11 by 4:30 pm.**
 - You are required to stand next to your poster during this assigned time.
- Poster numbers will be listed in the 2026 Onsite Program Book prefixed with a letter, which denotes the day of presentation i.e., FRI (Friday), SAT (Saturday), or SUN (Sunday). **These letters are not posted on the boards.** Presenters should mount their posters on the board bearing their assigned numbers, disregarding the letter prefix.
- The ASBMR Program Committee encourages senior authors to give any young investigator authors of the abstract the opportunity to present their science at the ASBMR 2026 Annual Meeting.
- **Poster boards are four feet high and eight feet wide (4' x 8').** They are made to accept pushpins or Velcro fasteners, which you must supply.
- Poster material must be prepared in advance and be large enough to be viewed from a distance of three feet (90 cm.)
- Each poster must have a label at the top listing the title of the paper and the names and affiliations of authors. Characters in the title must be at least one inch (2.5 cm) high.
- Drawings should be simple with bold lines.
- Supply your own pushpins or Velcro fasteners for mounting materials to poster boards.
- Authors must be at their posters during the designated poster session and must be available to answer questions during the period specifically prescribed for the presentation of their posters.
- ASBMR accepts no liability for posters or poster materials and will not adjudicate disputes between abstract presenters.
- Posters must be removed during the dismantling hours. Posters that remain after that time will be discarded.
